



Multidimensional Impacts on Social Development and the Social Fabric; Innovative Solutions for Social Protection, Inclusion, and Justice: The Suffering of Palestinian Families Under Occupation.

For over five decades, the State of Palestine has endured continuous military occupation marked by systematic violence, forced displacement, and blockade-particularly in Gaza. Recent escalations have caused an unprecedented humanitarian catastrophe, restricting social development and dismantling the social fabric. Over 2.1 million civilians in Gaza live under a suffocating blockade, facing mass displacement and destruction of homes and livelihoods. The West Bank also suffers from intensifying settler violence, economic suffocation, and deliberate targeting of civilian infrastructure.

This side event, co-organized by the Ministry of Social Development / State of Palestine, State of Qatar, UNDP, and UNICEF, highlights the urgent need to protect Palestinian families and rebuild the social fabric through a rights-based, shock-responsive social protection system grounded in justice, equity, and sustainability.

Role of the Ministry of Social Development

National Social Registry

A centralized platform to track beneficiaries and update data in real-time.

Operational Recommendations

Ensure transparency and accountability at every stage of assistance delivery.

Solidarity Network

Bringing together civil society, governments, and donors under one collaborative umbrella.

Emergency Cash Transfer (CTP)

Rapid and accurate delivery of financial assistance to affected families.

Protection Programs for Vulnerable Groups

Orphan sponsorships, Support for persons with disabilities, Elderly care.

International Coordination

Strategic partnerships with World Bank, UNDP, UNICEF, OCHA, WHO, WFP, ILO... etc
