



The Suffering of Palestinian Families under Occupation: Multidimensional Impacts on the Social Fabric and the Urgent Need for Protection, Scalable Solutions, and Justice

More than five decades of systematic military occupation, forced displacement, and blockade have resulted in a humanitarian catastrophe that has deeply fractured the fabric of Palestinian society—most notably in Gaza, where 2.1 million people have been affected in unprecedented ways.

There is an urgent need to rebuild a rights-based social protection system that is shock-responsive, grounded in justice and equity, and designed for long-term sustainability.
